



Defence Support Hub

The project

The Northern Territory Government has earmarked 53 hectares of land for the establishment of a Defence Support Hub industrial estate near to the Australian Army's Robertson Barracks in the Shire of Litchfield.

The Defence Support Hub is designed to allow prime contractors and sub contractors to deliver industry support to the Australian Department of Defence, focusing on through life support for Defence platforms including armoured vehicles.

The broad vision for the Defence Support Hub industrial estate also includes attracting manufacturing, research and development, and associated activities that will support Defence in its operations while providing benefits to the Northern Territory economy.

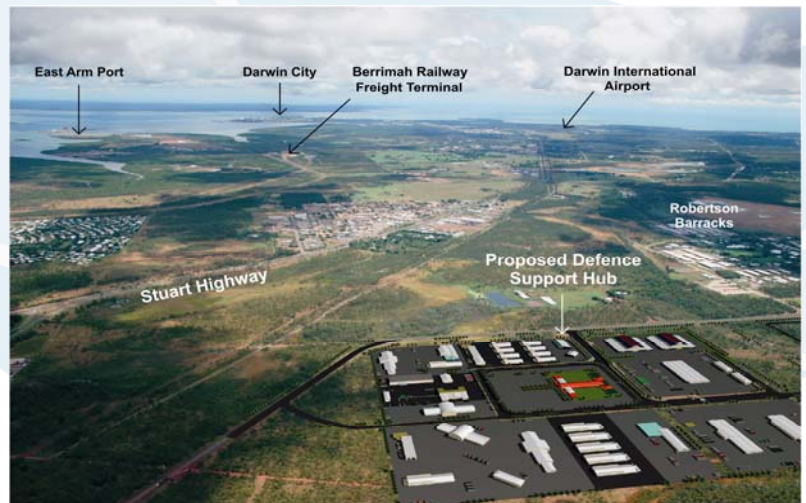
It is expected that the local through life support capability will give rise to capacities to undertake other work for Defence and for industries utilising similar technologies. These industries include mining, oil and gas, commodities processing and transport. This enhanced capacity will in turn attract further Defence and non-defence related contracts to Darwin.

The Defence Support Hub industrial estate has the potential to be a strategic asset for development of Northern Territory industry and the economy.

Current Status

A public tender for construction of stage 1 of the Defence Support Hub is scheduled to be advertised late June 2009.

Stage 1 will comprise of four serviced lots and associated access.
